

Landscape Architect to be Guest Speaker

This year's Cornwall Architectural Trust Annual Lecture is to be delivered by leading international landscape architect Andrew Grant, whose Gardens by the Bay project in Singapore opened earlier this year.

The lecture is to take place before an invited audience of leading figures in design, construction and procurement at Truro College's Fal Building on 23 November 2012. This is the lecture's twenty-fifth anniversary and previous speakers have included architects, engineers, academics and product designers, all leading figures in their respective fields.

"We are delighted to have Andrew Grant as our guest speaker," remarked Matt Wills, Chairman of the Cornwall Branch of the Royal Institute of British Architects. "This is the first time we have invited a landscape architect and getting Andrew is something of a coup."

The Cornwall Architectural Trust is a charity dedicated to the advancement of the understanding of architecture and the built environment. It also awards travelling scholarships, student prizes and, from time to time, makes an award to those who have made a major contribution to design in Cornwall.
